New IRS Form 990: A Focus on Board Governance

The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) is in the process of revising the tax reporting form that nonprofit organizations must file. The new IRS Form 990 will require non-profit organizations to report on numerous elements related to board oversight, governance and relationships with other nonprofit organizations. This training will provide critical information that board members need to have in order to prepare for and be compliant with the new IRS reporting requirements.
